Speaker: Professor Ananya Jahanara Kabir FBA, King's College London.

Ananya is Professor of English Literature at King's College London and Fellow of the British Academy. Her research into the history of African heritage social dances and the reasons for their global popularity has been funded by national and international grants and has won her academic recognition in Europe and India. Ananya is now starting a new research project on Dutch and Portuguese heritage across Atlantic and Indian Ocean world sites, including Galle and Jaffna in Sri Lanka.
