Directions

Chelmarsh SC is on the Welsh side of the Severn Valley. Best access is by taking the B4555.

- If travelling southwards you will see the reservoir on your left. After the Bull Inn in Chelmarsh take first left into the access lane.
- If travelling northwards the right turn into the access lane is at Sutton. Follow the lane eastwards for about 1 mile past the south end of the lake to the Sailing Club.

Sat Navs Beware

If you enter the postcode into a Sat Nav it is likely to try to take you over a foot bridge at the end of a track and it is a long drive around! Best to enter 'B4555' or 'Sutton'.

Camping
