SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

To be read in conjunction with the 2026 RS Association Standard Sailing Instructions

3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the window of the training room in the South-East corner of the ground floor of the CVLSC clubhouse.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the South-East corner of the CVLSC clubhouse.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races are about to begin, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with one sound signal at least 2 minutes before the first warning signal is made. This changes Standard SI 6.2.

7 CLASS FLAGS

RS100	RS100 Class Flag or if not available Flag A
RS400	RS400 Class Flag or if not available Flag B
RS700	RS700 Class Flag or if not available Flag T

9 COURSES

9.1 Courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward. The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be passed. The RS700 fleet will use the longer mark 1 windward mark and the RS100 & RS400 fleets will use the shorter mark 1A.

10 MARKS

Marks 1, 1A, 4S and 4P will be large Orange inflatables and will be described at the briefing (the numbers on the marks will not correspond to their position on the course). The start mark will be a buoy with a Orange flag, the finish mark will be a buoy with a Blue flag.

11 OBSTRUCTIONS

Competitors should leave a minimum distance of 25m from fishing boats & hatchery nets, and 50m from shore based fishing. A prohibited zone created by this sailing instruction is an obstruction.


17.4 Hearings will be held in the protest room in the training room in the South-East corner of the ground floor of the CVLSC clubhouse.
