



# CHEW VALLEY LAKE SAILING CLUB RS 200 Ugly Tour RS 100 Inland National Championships

Sat. 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2021 (Sun. 24<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2021 also for RS100s) SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (to Standard RS S.I.s)

## 1. RULES

1.1 The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of sailing, the Rules of the RS Class Associations, the Rules of Chew Valley Lake Sailing Club Ltd. and the Bristol Water PLC byelaws. Competitors will also behave in accordance with the RYA Racing Charter.

# 2. SAILING AREA

- 2.1 The sailing area is limited by lines of buoys which are continuing obstructions for RRS18 and RRS 19. A boat shall not sail outside this sailing area at any time except in an emergency.
- 2.2 A boat shall launch and come ashore only at the slipways and the adjacent shore unless in an emergency.
- 2.3 A boat shall not sail within 50 metres of a fisherman on the shore, or within 25 metres of a fishing boat. A prohibited zone created by this Sailing Instruction is an obstruction.

# 3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3.1 The official notice board will be on an external window to the CVLSC clubhouse

#### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the race office flagstaff which is above the registration room.
- 4.2 When Flag 'AP' is flown ashore race signal AP is changed such that "1 minute" is replaced by 'not less than 30 minutes'.

#### **5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 5.1 Sat. 23rd Briefing 11.15
- 5.2 Race 1 warning at 12.00 hours the intention is to sail 4 races back to back.
- 5.3 Up to 5 races may be sailed on Saturday for the 100 fleet if time allows.
- 5.4 The starting sequence will be explained at the briefing.
- 5.5 Sun.24<sup>th</sup> Oct. The 1<sup>st</sup> Race of the day for the 100 fleet will not start before 10.30am.

#### 6. THE COURSE

- 6.1 The course to be used is shown in Appendix A.
- 6.2 The number of Laps to be sailed will be displayed on the Committee Boat.

# 7. CLASS FLAGS

7.1 The Class Flags to be used will be described at the briefing.

## 8. MARKS

8.1 Marks will be large inflatable orange buoys.

## 9. THE START

- 9.1 The start line will be between a Committee Boat flying an Orange flag and either a mark or a vessel flying an orange flag.
- 9.2 The starting order will be described at the briefing.

## **10. THE FINISH**

10.1 The finish line will be between a committee boat displaying an blue flag and a mark displaying a blue flag.

## **11. TARGET TIME**

- 11.1 The target time for the lead boat will be around 45 minutes.
- 11.2 Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1(a).

# **12. PROTESTS**

- 12.1 Protest forms are available from the Race Office.
- 12.2 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day, or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is the later.
- 12.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses.
- 12.4 Notices of protests by the race committee will be posted to inform boats under Rule 61.1(b).
- 12.5 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for re-opening a hearing shall be delivered: Within the protest time limit if the requesting party was informed of the decision on the previous day.

No later than 30 minutes after the requesting party was informed of the decision on that day. This changes Rule 66.

- 12.6 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for redress based on a protest committee decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes Rule 62.2.
  - 12.7 RYA Advisory and Arbitration hearings may be available.


# **13. SCORING**

- 13.1 The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 13.2 When 3 races have been completed, a boat may discard her worst score.

#### **14. RUBBISH DISPOSAL**

14.1 Rubbish may be placed aboard support or safety boats. It must not be deposited in Chew Valley Lake.





Start One Lap : Start, 1p, 1a p, 2bp, Finish.

Two Laps : Start, 1p, 1a p, 2as/2bp, 1p, 1a p, 2bp, Finish.

Three Laps : Start, 1p, 1a p, 2as/2bp, 1p, 1a p, 2as/2bp, 1p, 1a p, 2bp, Finish.
