

Sailing Instructions Christmas Pursuit Race Sunday 15 December 2024

It is expected that the course will be finalised around 0930 on Sunday morning and published (see App1 pt4) immediately thereafter.

There will be no formal competitor briefing but the Race Officer will be available in the café between 0930 and 1000 on Sunday morning to answer any questions

[DP] before a rule indicates that a penalty other than disqualification may be applied by the Race Committee.

[NP] Before a rule indicates that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS60.1

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024
- 1.2 SAIL NUMBERS A boat shall not race with an incorrect sail number unless she has notified the office when entering. Even when such confirmation is received the Race Committee does not have the authority to amend the requirements of class rules. As a result, a boat could be protested for failing to comply with class rules.

2. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.

3. COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at Club Noticeboard | Grafham Water Sailing Club
- 3.2 From the first warning signal until the end of the race, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. CODE OF CONDUCT

4.1 [DP] Grafham Water Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and competitors will be expected to sail in compliance with it. The Charter can be found at the front of the RYA edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (the yellow pages after the definitions), or on the RYA website at www.rya.org.uk/racingrules.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on flagpole 1. Signals may be announced on the tannoy as well.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the Race Signal AP.



6. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 The warning signal (3 minutes) for the first start (RS Tera Sport) will be no earlier than 10:47
- 6.2 To alert boats that a race or sequence of races will begin soon, the orange starting line flag will be displayed with multiple sound signals at least one minute before the first warning signal is made

7. CLASS FLAGS

7.1 No class or fleet flags will be used for starting signals

8. RACING AREA

8.1 The racing area will be defined by the fixed buoys used for the Course. The start is expected to be in the vicinity of Club buoy.

9. COURSES

10. MARKS

10.1 Marks used will be the fixed marks as shown on the lake map and in Appendix 1

11. [DP] OBSTRUCTIONS

- 11.1 The prohibited area at the West end of the water is an obstruction. Its boundary is a line of small yellow buoys forming its eastern boundary.
- 11.2 Each fishing boat, and an area extending 20 metres in any direction from the fishing boat is a prohibited area and an obstruction.
- 11.3 A safety boat in close attendance to a craft or competitor in difficulty is an obstruction and a prohibited area. Boats must not sail between the safety boat and the craft or competitor in difficulty.

12. THE START

- 12.1 The starting line will be between the mast on the Committee boat flying an orange flag and a Dan buoy carrying an orange flag.
- 12.2 Starts will be indicated by a number displayed on boards on the committee boat. These will be changed with a sound signal every minute until 11:41 or for as long as there are starters in the starting area.
- 12.3The visual starting signals are the number boards. Times will be taken however from the sound signals: this changes Rule 26.
- 12.3 The scheduled start times for classes are as listed in Appendix 2.
- 12.4 [DP] The warning signal for each class is deemed to be 3 minutes before its Starting Signal, and the Preparatory Signal deemed to be 2 minutes before the Starting Signal. (this changes RRS 26). Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races.
- 12.5 In the event of a postponement after the Preparatory Signal by displaying pennant AP, the numeral board is removed for re-use. The sequence will be restarted one minute after the removal of AP by re-displaying the numeral board and resuming the one minute sequence. This modifies the interpretation of Race Signal AP in the Racing Rules of Sailing.



- 12.6 Individual recalls will be signalled by displaying flag X with one sound signal as detailed in RRS29, except that the flag will be removed on the next sound signal.
- 13. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE (Does not apply)

14. THE FINISH

- 14.1 The Race ends at 12:15, or 85 minutes after the initial start signal if later. Finish ranking is the order of boats on the water, the leader being finished at 12:15, the boats following as soon as possible afterwards.
- 14.2 Near the end of the race boats should keep within 50meters of the centreline of their sailing leg to make sure they receive a finish, especially if beating or tacking downwind.
- 14.3 Note the boats next in front and behind you at the finish time and continue sailing until your finish has been recorded from a RIB or Committee boat. After the finish time do not change order with boats ahead or behind you until your finish has been so recorded.

15. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 15.1 For all competitors RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 15.2 No boat need display a protest flag

16. TIME LIMITS

16.1 The target finishing time is 1215, or 85 minutes after the initial start signal if later

17. HEARING REQUESTS


- 17.1 The protest time limit is 45 minutes after the last boat finishes the race, or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 17.2 Hearing request forms are available from the club office.
- 17.3 Hearings will be held as soon after the conclusion of racing as is possible
- 17.4 Advisory hearings, post race penalty and RYA Arbitration are available as described in the Club Winter Series SIs 17.4, 17.5 and 17.6



Appendix 1

Course

- 1 The course will be chosen depending on the wind direction and strength.
- 2 The Course will use the Club's fixed marks as shown on the map below and on the Club's Lake Map
- 3 Marks will be listed in order with rounding direction (p-port, s-starboard).
- 4 The Course will be announced on the morning of the race and displayed ashore (in the Café), on the online noticeboard and on the Committee Boat.
- 5 After rounding the final mark in the Course sequence continue again to the first mark in the sequence again and sail marks in the order listed until the race ends **AND** you are finished on the water.
- 6 Boats must not pass through the starting line when sailing in a downwind direction
- 7 Boats which fail to start or finish correctly or to sail the course as set and thus fail to comply with RRS28 may be disqualified without protest or a hearing
