



Instructions for overnight Campers and Campervans

All camper van and camping slots need to be booked.

On arrival please stop at the Gate hut.

Tents: Please collect your permit to camp. This needs to be displayed on your tent for the duration of your stay. You may take your car to the camping area to unload but then please return it to the Visitors Car Park. You do not need to be in a certain space as long as you are within the camping area.

Campervans: Please collect your Campervan permit and display it in the windscreen, making sure that it is visible from the outside. Please park only in your allocated space. Campervan pitch numbers are marked on the ground. If in pitch numbers CV5 to CV 8, or CV9 to CV13 and CV24 please park behind white painted line on ground.

Showers, changing rooms and toilets (on the middle floor of the Clubhouse) will be available throughout the weekend. Please use the front doors at the top of the stairs to access these overnight. When using the changing rooms please do not plug electric clothes driers into the sockets (they blow the fuses!).

There is a drinking water tap (marked as such) on the east side of the Clubhouse.

Please do not build any kind of open fire, and please do not use disposable barbeques. Gas fired barbeques are OK.

Please note there is no admittance to the fire escapes at the sides of the clubhouse.

The site closes and is locked at 6:30pm on Sunday: please ensure you are packed up and away by then.
