RYA TASTER SESSIONS

We run both Youth and Adult taster sessions for members and non-members. These are under the guidance of an instructor and are designed to give you an introduction to Sailing , Winging, Windsurfing or Windfoiling. During the session you will have the opportunity to practise basic skills. After the initial taster session, membership is required to attend further training. Minimum age is 8 years. Other days and times may be available on request.

Dinghy Taster Sessions

These run on a Saturday. Available as a one, two or three hour session at £35 per hour. We will allocate the time when the booking is confirmed. If you have a preference, please contact us before booking.

Wingsurfing Wednesdays – New for this Year!

Our wingsurfing courses will introduce you to flying the wing and feeling confident on the water using an inflatable wing with a beginner windsurf board. No previous experience necessary.

It includes all the equipment needed and a buoyancy aid. We do highly recommend that you wear a wetsuit, which is not provided.

Wingsurfing then leads on to Wingfoiling.

The session is run for a minimum of two people.

There is also an evening meal available in the Top Bar afterwards if you wish.

Wingfoiling Taster Sessions

An introduction to Wingfoiling for Youths and Adults who have already completed a Wingsurfing session. These take place on weekdays. Wetsuits and boots are compulsory, however, not provided. All other equipment including buoyancy aid and helmet are included.


The training courses described in this booklet are for Club members. Those wishing to book a full course who are not already members may take out a three-month course membership.

RYA YOUTH DINGHY COURSES



RYA Youth Beginner Sailing Course - RYA Stage 1 & 2

On this course you will go from beginner to confident sailor in an intensive week-long course. By the end of the Stage 1 course, you will have a basic understanding of how a boat sails, and some experience of steering and handling the boat.

By the end of the Stage 2 course, you will have a range of sailing skills and background knowledge and be well on the way to being a confident small boat sailor.

The course topics in the RYA curriculum will be signed off in your logbook as you achieve them. At the end of the course, we will issue you with an action plan to detail the next steps in your sailing development. If any sections cannot be completed satisfactorily the action plan will explain how you can achieve this.

Our Saturday afternoon "Team Grafham" session is the ideal next step (page 14).

RYA Youth Improvers Sailing Course - RYA Stage 3 & 4

You must have the knowledge and skills of a Stage 2 sailor and additional recent practice. Before booking you need to attend a pre-course assessment. These are available during our Team Grafham sessions (see page 14).

Having completed Stage 3 you will be able to sail in any direction and rig and launch your boat. Your skills and knowledge mean that you can regard yourself as a sailor not a beginner. A stage 4 certificate means that you have the skills to sail a double-handed boat as crew or helm and solve a variety of problems afloat. Passing this course is the natural entry point for the advanced courses.

RYA Advanced Youth Courses

These are courses for the more experienced Youth sailor. You will need to be able to sail to a Stage 4 standard and must have attended Team Grafham regularly (see page 14).

RYA Seamanship Skills

This course will help you learn skills a short step beyond Stage 4. During this course you will polish and test your skills and learn to resolve problems afloat. The course will give you a solid foundation for the future and enable you to become much more confident and self-sufficient afloat.

RYA Sailing With Spinnakers

A very short but fun and thrilling syllabus which probably packs the most enjoyment of all the RYA courses. Everything you need to know to enjoy modern three-sail boats.


RYA Performance Sailing

Improve your boat-handling and confidence in performance boats. This is an opportunity to be coached, practice your helming and crewing and work on a smooth fluent sailing performance with or without the spinnaker.

RYA ADULT DINGHY COURSES



RYA Adult Level 1 Course – RYA Start Sailing

This course provides a short introduction to sailing for novices. By the end of the course, you will have the basic understanding of dinghy-handling techniques and background knowledge. It is recommended that all participants consolidate this short introduction with the Basic Skills course.

RYA Adult Level 2 Course – RYA Basic Skills

On completion of this course, you will have a basic knowledge of sailing and be capable of sailing without an instructor on board in light winds. It will be assumed that every student starting this course has already mastered the practical skills and absorbed the background knowledge required for Start Sailing.

RYA Adult Level 1 & 2 Course – RYA Start Sailing and Basic Skills

This five-day intensive option follows the same syllabus as the two-day Level 1 and 2 courses (see above) and with additional time with an instructor to develop your skills.

On completion of this course the successful sailor will be safety conscious and capable of sailing without an instructor on board in light to moderate conditions.

This improver course seeks to bridge the gap between Start Sailing, Basic Skills and the five Advanced modules by offering an introduction to the different modules, allowing sailors to select better their preferred route within the sport.

RYA Assistant Dinghy Instructor Course

Participants will need to be at an advanced level of Dinghy Sailing and have a recommendation from our Chief Instructor to take part in this course. The course covers basic teaching principles, centre procedures and specific training in any unfamiliar equipment (see RYA book G14). Candidates will be assessed on their teaching ability with beginners. You will then assist our qualified Instructors.

Minimum age is 14.

Please note that this is a Centre Specific qualification and can only be used at GWSC. Please enquire at the Office.

RYA Dinghy Instructor Course


The dinghy instructor course takes experienced sailors through the basic skills, knowledge and teaching techniques required to instruct, coach, and develop sailors of all levels of ability. There will be a maximum of six students and includes all relevant handbooks and logbooks from the RYA National and Youth Sailing Schemes.

A pre-entry assessment is required to confirm that you have the sailing ability and background knowledge required to become an instructor. You will be asked to sail a triangular course efficiently and must also successfully complete a variety of sailing manoeuvres. This is one of a number of qualifying criteria that should be met before your dinghy instructor course starts. Minimum age is 16.

RYA POWERBOATING COURSES

RYA Start Powerboating Course – RYA Level 1

This course is an introduction to boating techniques for launching and recovering a boat from a road trailer, everyday boat handling and the use of safety equipment.

RYA Powerboat Handling Course – RYA Level 2

This two-day entry level course provides the skills and background knowledge needed to drive a powerboat and is the basis of the International Certificate of Competence (ICC). It focuses on low-speed close quarters handling, man overboard recovery, an introduction to driving at planing speed, and collision regulations. No prior experience required.

RYA Safety Boat Course

This course covers the skills and techniques applicable to providing rescue cover at the club or when assisting with racing events. We will practise rescuing dinghies, catamarans, and windsurfers, as well as introducing basic elements of race management and mark-laying. It is ideal for competent powerboaters who are keen to become more involved with safety duties and open meeting events at the club.

Please note that RYA Powerboat Level 2 and a basic understanding of sailing boats and windsurf boards must be held prior to this course.

The on the water element forms part of the overall assessment and this is carried out continuously. There is no formal examination associated with this seminar.

Team Grafham Intermediate provides an opportunity to develop skills and confidence. We include race training and seamanship skills for the more experienced sailors in Team Grafham Advanced.

These sessions are a great way to improve your sailing skills as well as having lots of fun and meeting other young sailors.

Team Grafham is also where we carry out pre-course assessments for those who want to attend our more advanced courses.
