All hats must have the current BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing. The Official Steward at the competition will be able to tag your hat for you if it doesn't already have one.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with the current BRC Rulebook. There is a checking device on the BRC website, but please call the BRC team if you need reassurance that the dates are valid.

Protective Headgear

Protective Headgear must be worn at all times by anyone, whether or not a Competitor, riding anywhere at this event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. At all BRC Championships and qualifiers Protective Headgear must show a visible BRC hat tag. Protective Headgear constitutes a hat which meets one of the standards as set out by BRC.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The current rulebook is available to download online. If you have a query regarding these rules, please ring BRC on 02476 840593, or speak to your Team captain.

Running Order

In order to run the day efficiently, competitors will be given riding times. This event will run as per Option 3, where only riders with Double clear will go forward to the Jump off part of the course. The Bell will be rung to stop riders continuing to the Jump off. Please speak with your Team manager to explain this riding option for this event.

Passport Checking
