Kari Anne Helleberg Bahri, a graduate of the National Academy of Art in Oslo, is a Norwegian contemporary textile artist. Her sculptures are found in many public and private collections. Her work does not follow the more typical Norwegian minimalist style but reflects the melancholy and cold temperament of Northern Europe. Kari Anne has created her own language in textile art using discarded or abandoned readymade objects, for example fragments of old clothes and rags, which she restitches into clothes-like works to show the mind, thoughts and personality of those who might have worn them and to tell their story.

An exhibition tour for LAHS members on 6th March 2026 at the Bluerider ART Gallery exhibition 'Kari Anne Helleberg Bahri: The Second Skin' will focus on the world through her textile sculptures, offering the opportunity to be immersed in compelling contemporary artworks that delve below the surface of social disguise.
