Our visit to Pitzhanger Manor and Gallery consists of two tours. Although it is possible to book both tours, the two overlap.

Tour 1 Classic Tour

Pitzhanger Manor was the country home of Sir John Soane, one of the most influential architects in British history. Soane designed many extraordinary buildings but this one is unique because it was designed, built and lived in by Soane himself. This tour also explores Soane's life, including his grand tour, family and career.

Tour 2 JMW Turner and John Soane Tour

Discover the rich history between artist JMW Turner and architect John Soane. Explore their friendship, Turner's frequent visits to Pitzhanger and the artistic influences they shared. The tour highlights Turner's works that would have been displayed at Pitzhanger and includes anecdotes about their fishing trips and shared passions. This tour offers a unique glimpse into the lives of two prominent figures of the Royal Academy. *NB there is some overlap between the 2 tours.*

Exhibition Peter Blake: in the Studio

At the time of our visit, there will be a major exhibition showcasing the life and work of one of the most celebrated and influential artists of 20th century Britain – Sir Peter Blake. In a career spanning seven decades, Blake has become the defining figure of British Pop Art with his paintings, collages, prints and albums. *For further details see Pitzhanger Manor website*
