

# ***RYA Powerboat Level 2 Course***

## ***Pre-course Information***

Thank you for your booking and on behalf of Draycote Water Sailing Club, we look forward to welcoming you to the course.

**Courses start from 09:30 and will finish around 16:00 on both days.**

**Children must be signed in and out by an adult each day.**

### **Getting here & parking**

Use the postcode CV23 8AB and park for free in the Sailing Club car park (first on the right hand side).

Please be aware ANPR operates onsite for parking charges, you do not need to pay for parking as long as you enter your car registration into a tablet at the clubhouse each day of your course.

Walk to the Sailing Club following the signposts (approx. 5 minutes). On the patio by the waters edge you will find the waterside reception, please register here and meet your instructor.



### **What to bring**

You will be spending most of the time on the water but please be aware that it will be cold and maybe wet too, so you will need to bring the following items:

- Appropriate clothing - if it's dry and hot, jumper and shorts are acceptable, but in anything but perfect conditions, waterproof tops and trousers are highly recommended, if in doubt bring waterproofs
- Footwear – which will get wet, wellies are ideal if its wet weather or trainers that can get wet if it's warm weather
- Towel
- Sun cream, sun glasses
- Hat - either sunhat for shade or a winter hat for warmth
- Gloves
- Lunch & drink (the onsite café is open at weekends)
- **Passport sized photo - your certificate can not be issued without this**

Please leave high valued items at home (small lockers are available and require a returnable £1 coin).

Shower facilities and changing rooms are available.

**We will provide each person with a buoyancy aid and RYA start power boating book (and certificate where applicable)**
