We suggest: Wear clothing you can easily move around in, and tie long hair back Bring sun hat, suncream, water, for summer courses bring hat, gloves, scarf, layers for winter courses Bring waterproofs whatever the weather – it can turn
	 We can provide a buoyancy aid, just let you instructor know if you need one when you arrive Bring plenty of drinks/snacks and lunch with you (Catering will not be open that day)
	You need to bring with you a passport photo so that we can issue your certificate.
