what3words///[claim.lecturing.agency](#) at 0845hrs for a 0900hrs start Bring suitable clothing for sailing on the sea eg warm, windproof and waterproof. Ensure you have appropriate non-slip footwear preferably waterproof. Wear layers. Expect to get wet from spray (you will not be entering the water) . Bring a towel and dry clothes and footwear to go home in.
- Bring sunscreen, sunglasses and a peaked hat with some string to tie to your collar in case it blows off..
- Please bring your life jacket or buoyancy aid if you have one. We can provide one if required, but you must let us know in advance if one is needed.
 - You have to wear a buoyancy aid or lifejacket on the boats and pontoons at all times.
- You may wish to bring a packed lunch or money to buy food at the Fort Road café or local shops.
- Don't forget to bring water.
- Bring a passport photo with you to the first session and write your name on the back. Without this we can't have your certificate ready for you on day two.
- Let your instructor know if you have any medical problems that may affect your enjoyment of powerboating.
- Valuables should be left locked in your car
- There is free parking at Seaford and Piddinghoe. Parking at Newhaven Marina is restricted to those with permits. If needed, you will be given a parking permit which should be returned to your instructor at the end of the day.

Please note – the RYA PB2 can be converted to an ICC (International Certificate of Competency) for use in countries outside the UK where they do not recognise the PB2 certificate. Please ask if you wish to have further information.
