#### **Arrival Information**

Welcome to the Parkstone Optimist Open Meeting, and welcome to Parkstone YC.

As you may know, Parkstone YC is in the process of building a new club building, and this will have some impact on the Optimist Open. The club is fully functional in terms of facilities, but a few areas are cordoned off and some special arrangements are in place. Please bear with us in working around these constraints. Your cooperation is appreciated at this time.

#### **Upon arrival**

- Access to the club will be available from 0730, Saturday, 21<sup>st</sup> May.
- If **roof-topping** your Optimist, please initially park **in the top members car park**. Unload your boat and walk it down to the designated Main Fleet (MF) or Regatta Fleet (RF) boat park areas. Please **remove your vehicle to Pearce Avenue** as soon as possible.
- If towing an Optimist trailer, please proceed to drive down through the gate, and around the back of the Chandlery. Unhook, take out bags and kit, park trailer along front of brown sheds as shown and remove your vehicle to Pearce Avenue.
- If **bringing a RIB**, please proceed to the "unhook area" near the launch ramp. Unload your Optimists and launch your RIB, then please **remove your vehicle to Pearce Avenue**. Please move your RIB trailer to the area shown in far Northern corner of the yard.

# **Changing Rooms**

The changing rooms are in the same place as before, but access is **from the deck on the water side of the clubhouse.** 

# Chandlery

As part of the club house rebuild the chandlery facilities have been significantly upgraded and these are already in place. You can't miss it, just through the gate. Pete, from Keywest Chandlery, is extremely helpful and stocks a wide range of Optimist specific kit.

#### **Post Rigging**

If in main fleet, once rigged up you can move your boat to the slipway, as the Optimists will launch first on both Saturday and Sunday.

#### Clubhouse

You are very welcome in the club, with its bar and catering. Please bear in mind that this is **dry area**.

# **Boat storage during Saturday night**

Please help us in arranging your Optimists in a tidy manner in the designated areas for overnight storage. There will be Club Youth Sailing on the Sunday morning, and tidy storage of the Optimists will be crucial to making this work smoothly.

#### Food

There will be sailor's pasta on Saturday afternoon. Tickets will be available at registration for sailors and available to purchase at £5 for siblings and parents. The aim is to have food ready half an hour after main fleet come off the water. Food will be served in the cruiser shed marked as the "registration area" on the Yard Layout diagram.

There will be free bacon butties for on-water volunteers on both days.
