## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen as supplied by the organising authority.

### 3. ENTRY

### 5. FEES

5.1. Entry fees are as follows:

- Entries before 18<sup>th</sup> September 2017 - £30
- Late Entries - £40

### 5. SCHEDULE

5.1. Registration at 11:00 Saturday 30th September 2017.

5.2. 3 races will be held on Saturday 30th September 2017.

5.3. 2 races will be held on Sunday 1st October 2017

5.4. First scheduled warning signal 13:00 hrs 30/9/2017

5.5. Sunday Racing will be finished before 14:00 to allow visitors to return home, and club racing to commence. Visitors who wish may join in the club racing in the afternoon.

### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

### 7. VENUE

7.1. Sailing will be in Carrick Roads to the east of Mylor.

7.3. Motor vehicles and camping Cars and other motor vehicles must not under any circumstances be taken into the Dinghy Park or beach. Competitors may not camp or sleep there overnight.

7.4. Windsport have kindly allowed visiting sailors to use their parking facilities under the following provisions:

7.4.1. Boat & trailer parking is for competitors only.

7.4.2. One car parking permit per entry

7.4.3. Access for all competitors will be up the Windsport Lane:

- Please drive slowly and carefully, respecting walkers and residence.
- All trailers and cars must display a Windsport permit at all times – Permits can be obtained upon registration of the event.
- Any vehicle / trailer not displaying a valid permit will be required to pay the daily rate directly to Windsport.
- Vehicles and boats must be removed by the end of Sunday evening.

## **8. THE COURSES**

8.1. The course will be described in the sailing instructions.

## **9. SCORING**

9.1. When three or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9.2. When less than three races have been completed all scores will be counted.

## **10. PRIZES**

10.1. There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.

## **11. RISK STATEMENT**

11.1. Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: “The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.” Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- 11.1.1. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew, their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 11.1.2. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 11.1.3. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 11.1.4. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 11.1.5. The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organising does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- 11.1.6. The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

## **12. INSURANCE**

12.1. Each participating boat shall be adequately insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2million per incident or equivalent.
