The organising authority is Rock Sailing and Waterski Club (RSWSC).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the individual competitor's Class Association.
- 1.2. The Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club (RSWSC) Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Shall comply with the World Sailing Advertising Code and the relevant rules of the individual competitor's Class Association. RSWSC may require the display of advertising material.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The World Sailing Sailor Classification Code shall not apply to this event.
- 3.2. Entry to the Open Meetings is open to the members and non-members of RSWSC .
- 3.3. Cost per boat is £150.00 for non-members and £45.00 for RSWSC members and free for RSWSC members with volunteer credit (as per Dutyman records)
- 3.4. Entrants are responsible for the cost river dues and berthing at Ferry Point.
- 3.5. The regatta is open:
 - 3.5.1. Dinghies with Portsmouth Yardstick: **799 – 1400**



3.5.2. Multihull boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick: **700 - 1200**

4. STARTS

- 4.1. There will be 2 dinghy starts based on Portsmouth Yardstick – Fast Handicap and Slow Handicap. The final decision on the cutoff point will depend on classes entered.
- 4.2. The multihulls will have a separate start.
- 4.3. There will be 5 minutes between each starts
- 4.4. Start sequence will be- multihulls; fast handicap; slow handicap
- 4.5. Starting flags:
 - 4.5.1. The Fast handicap will start under 'T' flag
 - 4.5.2. The Slow handicap will start under 'J' flag
 - 4.5.3. The multihulls will start under 'V' flag
 - 4.5.4. The pursuit races will start under the 8 pennant.


5. RESULTS AND PRIZES

- 5.1. The results will be published in the RSWSC Club House and on the RSWSC website as soon as practicable after each race.
- 5.2. Prizes will be awarded in the RSWSC Club House at the regatta prize giving on Thursday 21st August 2025 at 12:00 hrs.

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions for the regatta contain additional information regarding the regatta and will be available at the Club and online when entering.

8. SCORING


- 8.1. When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2. When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. VENUE and COURSES

- 9.1 The regatta is held in the River Camel and the Camel Estuary, Rock, Cornwall, and Padstow Bay
- 9.2 Courses will be displayed prior to the days racing in the RSWSC Club House, and on WhatsApp
- 9.3 Dogs are allowed on the Quay but not in the sailing club building.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Please refer to 'Rule 3, Decision to Race'. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury



or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. INSURANCE

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.


