1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the individual competitor's Class Association.
- 1.2. The Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club (RSWSC) Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions

2. ADVERTISING

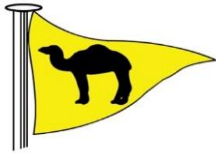
- 2.1. Shall comply with the World Sailing Advertising Code and the relevant rules of the individual competitor's Class Association. RSWSC may require the display of advertising material.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The World Sailing Sailor Classification Code shall not apply to this event.
- 3.2. Entry to the Open Meetings is open to the members and non-members of RSWSC .
- 3.3. Cost per boat is:
 - Visitors Early Bird Entry - £110.00 (until 23:59 on 07/07/2026)
 - Visitors Entry - £120.00 from 08/07/2026
 - Member Entry - £60.00
 - Members Entry - £30.00 (if have 3 scheduled duties on Dutyman)

3.4. Entrants are responsible for the cost river dues.

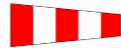
3.5. The regatta is open to Shrimper 19 class boats

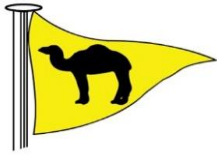
(Note – changes may be made to the above schedule based on weather or tidal conditions.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. The Sailing Instructions for the regatta contain additional information regarding the regatta and will be available at the Club and online when entering.

8. SCORING

8.1. When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.



- 8.2 When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

- 9.1 Savills will be hosting a 'Shrimper Drinks Party' for competitors on the quay from 18:00 on 10th August 2026.

10. VENUE and COURSES

- 9.1 The regatta is held in the River Camel and the Camel Estuary, Rock, Cornwall, and Padstow Bay
- 9.2 Courses will be displayed prior to the days racing in the RSWSC Club House, and on WhatsApp
- 9.3 Dogs are allowed on the Quay but not in the sailing club building.

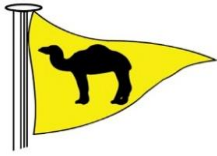
11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

APPENDIX: SAILING AREAS

Rock has several sailing areas which can be used, depending on whether the sea state and wind allow safe passage in the narrow channel around the famous 'Doom Bar' (marked with dotted line).
