The organising authority is Rock Sailing and Waterski Club (RSWSC).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the individual competitor's Class Association.
- 1.2. The Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club (RSWSC) Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Shall comply with the World Sailing Advertising Code and the relevant rules of the individual competitor's Class Association. RSWSC may require the display of advertising material.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The World Sailing Sailor Classification Code shall not apply to this event.
- 3.2. Entry to the Open Meetings is open to the members and non-members of RSWSC .
- 3.3. Cost per boat is:
 - Member Entry - £75.00
 - Member Entry (3 scheduled duties on Dutyman) - £37.50
 - Members Day Entry (maximum of 2 races) - £20.00 per race
 - Visitors Early Bird Entry (until 23:59 on 20/07/2026) - £130.00
 - Visitors Entry (from 21/07/2026) - £150.00
 - Visitor Day Entry (maximum of 2 races) - £37.50 per race
- 3.4. The Point will be providing events shirts and to ensure you get your correct size you must have entered online by 1st August 2026. A limited number additional shirts will be available for late entries but these will be of a first



come, first served basis. All shirts will be available for collection at registration

- 3.5. St Austell Brewery will be providing an event beverage which can be collected at registration.
- 3.6. Entrants are responsible for the cost river dues and berthing at Ferry Point.
- 3.7. The regatta is open to:

3.7.1. Dinghies with Portsmouth Yardstick: **799 – 1400**

3.7.2. Multihull boats with a Portsmouth Yardstick: **700 - 1200**

4. STARTS

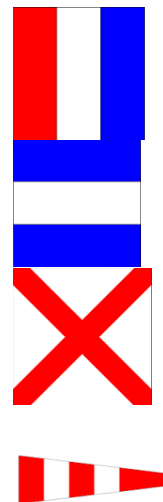
- 4.1. There will be 2 dinghy starts based on Portsmouth Yardstick – Fast Handicap and Slow Handicap. The final decision on the cutoff point will depend on classes entered.
- 4.2. The multihulls will have a separate start.
- 4.3. There will be 5 minutes between each start.
- 4.4. Start sequence will be- multihulls; fast handicap; slow handicap
- 4.5. Starting flags:

4.5.1 The Fast handicap will start under 'T' flag

4.5.2 The Slow handicap will start under 'J' flag

4.5.3 The multihulls will start under 'V' flag

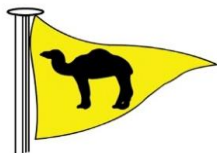
4.5.4 The pursuit races will start under the 8 pennant

8. SCORING

8.1. When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.2. When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. VENUE and COURSES

9.1 The regatta is held in the River Camel and the Camel Estuary, Rock, Cornwall, and Padstow Bay

APPENDIX: SAILING AREAS

Rock has several sailing areas which can be used, depending on whether the sea state and wind allow safe passage in the narrow channel around the famous 'Doom Bar' (marked with dotted line).
