

Rock Sailing and Waterski Club Notice of Race ILCA Open Friday 18th April to Monday 21st April 2025

1. RULES

- The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the RYA prescriptions and the rules of the individual competitor's Class Association.
- The Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club (RSWSC) Sailing Instructions (SI) will apply except as stated in any supplementary Sailing Instructions.

2. ADVERTISING

 Shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20 and the relevant rules of the individual competitor's Class Association. RSWSC may require the display of advertising material.

3. FLIGIBILITY AND FNTRY

- The ISAF Sailor Classification Code shall not apply to this event.
- Entry to the ICLA Open is open to the members and nonmembers of RSWSC.
- Entry fee:
 - RSWSC Members no fee
 - Non-members is £45
- The regatta is open to:
 - ICLA dinghies and single handed boats formally classed as 'Lasers'
- 4. Eligible boats may online at Rock Sailing and Water Ski Club: ILCA Open 2025

6. RESULTS AND PRIZES

- The results will be published in the RSWSC Club House and on the RSWSC web site as soon as practicable after each race.
- Prizes will be awarded at the regatta prize giving on Monday 21st
 April at 13.00 or as otherwise notified.

7. SCHEDULE and FORMAT

- Registration Friday 18th April from 17:00 to 18:00 followed by fish and chips (pay on the day)
- o Race, dates & times:
 - Race 1 Friday 18th April 08:30 hrs
 - Race 2 & 3 Saturday 19th April 09:00 hrs (Race 3 straight after race 2)
 - Race 4 & 5 Sunday 20th April 09:00 hrs (Race 5 straight after race 4)
 - Race 6 Monday 1st April 09:45 hrs
- The Bowden Trophy and prizes will be awarded for the ILCA Open.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND SCORING

- o Sailing Instructions will be available in the Club House.
- When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

 The Sailing Instructions will be available in the RSWSC Club House. The Sailing Instructions for the regatta contain additional information regarding the regatta.

VENUE and COURSES

- The regatta is held in the River Camel and the Camel Estuary, Rock, Cornwall.
- Courses will be displayed prior to the days racing in the RSWSC Club House, and on WhatsApp

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
 See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

 Every participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
