



Social / Event Information (Not Part of Formal Notice of Race)

- The club will be open to receive competitors, participants and visitors from 6pm on Friday 22nd Aug 2025 for early arrivals. Visitors must depart by noon on Monday 25th Aug 2025. Camping with shower and toilet facilities available for free.
- Well behaved dogs are welcome, but must remain out the club house and fenced area to the loch side of the club. Dogs must be kept on a lead when walking in farmer fields.
- There will be a Tuck Shop selling snacks, rolls and soft drinks during Saturday and Sunday mornings.
- A hog roast will be held on Saturday evening (freshly baked pizza options for vegetarians). Dinner tickets cost £15 per adult (£10 per child - 12 and under). Where possible, tickets should be bought in advance via webcollect to help plan catering – a few tickets will be available on the day.
- Breakfast rolls will be served on Sunday morning.
- A Ceilidh will be held in the clubhouse on Saturday evening.
- The club will run a bar on Friday and Saturday evening. Payment by cash or card will be accepted.
- A number of members of the club have severe peanut allergies. We therefore request that any products containing peanuts are not bought into or consumed within the clubhouse.
